## A note on the present volume

Commencing with the first number of the current volume 9, the Centre for Agricultural Publications and Documentation (Pudoc), Wageningen, will be responsible for the publication of the *Netherlands Journal of Agricultural Science*. Pudoc already publishes two other periodicals, viz. the fortnightly "Landbouwkundig Tijdschrift" (Agricultural Journal) and the quarterly "European Potato Journal", so that it has experience in this field.

The Editorial Board are therefore confident that the publication of the Netherlands Journal of Agricultural Science will be in good hands.

Pudoc has begun its task by altering the set-up of the Journal. A new cover has been designed and the typography of the contents has been altered accordingly. Pudoc has also been able to persuade the printers, who have been printing the Journal for the past eight years, to obtain a different style of type.

The net result is that the Journal's appearance has been brought more into line with modern standards, and we hope this will meet with the approval of our readers. The change-over from the old to the new set-up created a number of practical problems, the result being that this February issue has been somewhat delayed. We shall, however, do our best to ensure that the May issue actually appears in that month.

We should also like to draw the attention of our readers and co-workers to the details of the composition and the Secretariat of the Editorial Board, the Administration and correspondence address of the Journal, etc., which will be found on the inside of the cover. It will also be noted that the undersigned still continues in the post of managing editor, from which it may be concluded that despite all the changes in its appearance the lines on which the Journal is run have remained unaltered.
